The Master's Programme

Start & Duration

- ▶ Depending on the subject, the courses start in April or October.
- ▶ Two years of full-time study (four semesters).



Language & Admission Requirements

- ▶ We invite applications from all qualified students holding a good first degree.
- ▶ A good command of German is usually a precondition for studying successfully in Freiburg. Please note that the subjects vary in their specific language requirements.

- ▶ has excellent library facilities



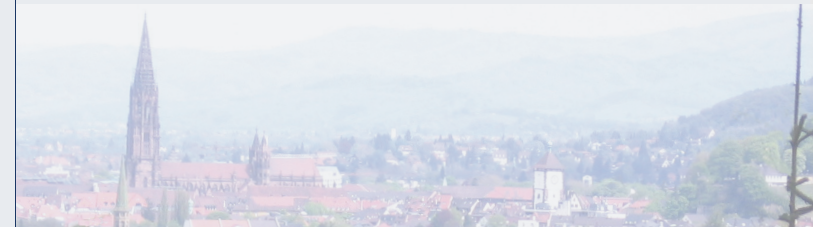
